

WOKING BOYS UNDER 18'S MATCH REPORT

Woking booked their place in the last 16 of the National Cup with an emphatic display against Eastcote in which they notched up 12 goals without reply and their keeper, Sam Goss, did not have a single save to make.

The first few minutes of this game was played at a whirlwind pace and within less than a minute Woking secured their first of 15 PC's which resulted in a drag flick goal scored by Chris. A minute and a half later they were 2 up when Fraser broke through into their D, took it to the bye line and passed back to Giles who drilled it home. The 3rd came in under 6 minutes when Tim replicated what Fraser had just done for the 2nd, but this time the pass back was to Fraser himself but although his shot hit the post, the rebound was snapped up by Giles. 3-0. Just over 3 minutes later Eastcote were totally demoralised when Chris took the ball into the D and reverse sticked a rocket into the back of the net. 4-0 in under 9 minutes. This was awesome hockey.

The next 10 minutes saw a number of Woking opportunities go begging, but it wasn't until the 20th that Woking scored once again following another PC, Chris with his 3rd of the game. Our 5th PC of the game came in the 28th minute and it heralded a routine change with Ollie receiving. He did a one two with Chris and scored Woking's 6th, keeping our conversion rate to over 50%.

Woking's 7th of the half came in the 31st minute when a shot into the D was cleverly deflected past the keeper by Will.

2nd Half

The 2nd period started at a less frenetic pace and saw Eastcote gain a bit more possession, but to no avail. And it was Woking that scored their 6th, 10 minutes in, when Will put away his second. Woking stepped up a gear again and thereafter followed 4 PC's in the space of 10 minutes, 2 of which were converted by Chris, taking his tally to 5 in all.

In the 65th minute saw some of Gilo's magic in the middle of the D with the keeper bringing him down. Chris B-B had no hesitation in awarding a Penalty Stroke and Giles stepped up, sent the keeper the wrong way and placed a low flick into the bottom right hand corner. 11-0 and a Giles Hat Trick.

To round the day off Mark set up Will to score his 3rd of the day and Woking's 12th in the 69th minute of the game.

The STATS speak for themselves.

22 Goals in the first 3 Rounds of the Cup with only 4 conceded.

Summary; Even more Exhibition Hockey. 5 from Chris Way and a hat trick from both Giles and Will. Although the PC conversion rate was down on the game against Trinity Mid-Whit, it was still 35%, 5 out of 14.
